Program Updates:

- Marin Coastal Permit Coordination Program Report 2015 CEQA was completed. Permits are now in review by agencies.
- **Urban Stream Coordinator** The USC conducted three site visits, worked with the County to revise an informative fact sheet on plant selection for onsite wastewater treatment systems, assisted Green Gulch Zen Center on a restoration day and has been busy planning future workshops and work days with a multitude of partners. Please see Board Report for further information.
- **Pine Gulch Restoration Project** Performed construction meetings with engineering staff. Several budget modifications have been necessary due to wet soils and archaeological discoveries. Construction challenges have caused changes to the project's scope of work and will require permit modifications however, the project remains on schedule.
- Marin Carbon Project Planning with San Mateo RCD and Carbon Cycle Institute for Carbon Farm workshop on August 10th. Two windbreak/hedgerows are scheduled for fall. Carbon Farming postcard was sent out to all agricultural producers in the County. Lynette will update Board on list of applicants. Met with Point Blue Rangeland Monitoring Initiative representatives to determine partnership opportunities.
- Americano Creek Watershed A Biochar workshop that was held at Swallow Valley Farm on July 25th. The Valley Ford Wool Mill Rain Catchment and Greywater System Design is complete and fundraising will begin soon.
- Tomales Bay/Walker Watershed 1 Tomales Riparian project is in progress. 1 Tomales Grade Stabilization project is scheduled for fall. 1 Dillon Beach Grade Stabilization repair is scheduled for this summer. 1 Lagunitas Road project is scheduled for fall.
- Media/Outreach: "Bolinas Farmers and Marin RCD Launch Water Storage Project to Protect Endangered Fish", Sonoma Marin Farm News.
- **Grant Proposals:** Prepared MOU for a shared engineering position for Sonoma and Marin RCDs, funded by NRCS.
