

CREEK PERMIT APPLICATION SUBMITTAL CHECKLIST

The following items shall be submitted as part of the creek permit application package to this office:

1. Completed Creek Permit application form (enclosed for your use)
 2. A written description of the project (you may refer to MCSTOPPP's website www.mcstoppp.org for additional details)
 3. Engineer's cost estimate of the work
 4. Complete construction plans:
 - a. Overall site map showing complete property boundary, fronting road and existing water course
 - b. Enlargement of proposed work area at scale of 1" = 20' or larger showing the existing top of bank, the proposed location of the top of bank, existing features (stone bridges), trees (existing, to be removed, etc.)
 - c. Volume of material to be removed
 - d. Existing and proposed bank cross sections, describing proposed bank slope
 - e. Proposed planting scheme
 - f. Construction details regarding erosion and sediment control measures, project phasing and timing, location of area accepting dredged material and the haul route,
 5. Hydrologic/hydraulic calculations shall demonstrate that the channel in between the constructed walls has the capacity to contain a 100 year storm (refer to MCC§24.04.520)
 6. Approval or letter of non-jurisdiction from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers*
 7. Approval from the California Department of Fish & Game*
 8. Approval or letter of non-jurisdiction from the Regional Water Quality Control Board*
 9. Creek Permit Application fee made payable to the County of Marin for \$220.00 (not the same as the plan check and permit fee)
 10. Plan Check Fee made payable to the County of Marin (2% of engineer's cost estimate for work, see item #3)
 11. CEQA review fee of \$400 made payable to County of Marin CDA
 12. Filing fee made payable to County Recorder for \$50.00 (the environmental document must be recorded as an official document).
- Note that items 6, 7 and 8 do not necessarily need to be provided with the initial application, but must be received by this office before the permit can be issued.
