Lecture Series—Beyond Emissions Reductions

The Forum Lecture Series is proud to start this year focusing on effective carbon capture projects in Marin.

Since 2007, Marin leaders in agriculture and agro-ecology have been working with local farmers and UC scientists to identify beneficial land management practices. These involve enhancing the conditions that promote the natural process of photosynthesis by increasing the amount of durable carbon sequestered and water retained in soils.

On Wednesday evening, January 13, Marin Carbon Project Co-Founder John Wick will review the steps that led to recognizing the potential of agriculture as an effective and environmentally beneficial means of lowering the amount of carbon dioxide in the air. John will provide an overview of these practices that promote the use of composted organic waste to enhance carbon sequestration. He will explain how we can all support these efforts through informed choices about our food, fiber, fuel, and flora.

A second lecture on Saturday morning, January 23, will offer a deeper dive into examples of specific efforts to utilize land management and related practices that remove carbon from the air. Speakers include Marin Carbon Farm Project Co-Founder, Dr. Jeffrey Creque; Carbon Cycle Institute Policy Director, Torri Estrada; Fibershed Founder, Rebecca Burgess; and Marin Sanitary Service Contacts and Communications Manager, Kimberly Scheibly.

Join us at one or both of these fascinating lectures to learn how we can reverse the impact of greenhouse gases while restoring the health of our soils.
