### **RCD Program Updates:**

International Ocean Acidification Meeting: Terry Sawyer

- Urban Streams Program: The USC has been busy preparing for a soil bioengineering workshop in collaboration with Regional Water Quality Control Board, MCSTOPPP, Friends of Corte Madera Creek, AmeriCorps and CA Urban Streams Partnership. As well, USC has conducted a handful of site visits with more to come in February. Planning meetings have been taking place in order to lay out the educational workshops and classes for 2017 via the USC Program. Finally, the collaborative nursery at Point Reyes Seashore is finally up and running with volunteers helping almost daily!
- **Finance Committee:** The Finance Committee has met and reviewed many of the action items listed on this agenda.
- **Marin Carbon Project** 3 carbon farm plans are complete. 4 drafts are complete. 3 are being initiated. All will be complete by June.
- Black Mountain Roads Tasks remaining: fencing and minor erosion control work.
- Americano Creek Watershed Gold Ridge RCD is proceeding with carbon farm planning.
- **Conserving Our Watersheds:** Nine projects are complete! Planting season is now underway. One of three projects has been completed by STRAW thus far.
- Media/Outreach: "MRCD awarded \$200,000 grant for carbon farming" by George Clyde in PReyes Light. "Marin RCD receives grant for carbon farming" by MALT
- Grant Proposals: RCD staff is currently working on a proposal to address roads in the Walker Creek watershed.
  - \$387K. CA Dept. Fish and Wildlife. Pending
  - \$400K. Wildlife Conservation Board. Pine Gulch. Pending
  - \$200K. State Coastal Conservancy. Carbon Farming. Awarded!
  - o \$600K. State Water Resources Control Board. Dairy Assistance. EPA Freeze
- **District:** The fiscal audit is near completion. Staff has been working on Tier 1 RCD compliance. After this meeting, the following requirements remain to be met: Ethics Training for 2 directors, Nondiscrimination Training for all directors, Volunteer Policy, Strategic Plan and Annual Plan. If we meet Tier 1 minimum requirements, we will be eligible to receive \$30K from the Department of Conservation for other programs.
- Landowner Requests: 17 stakeholders requested assistance in December/January.
