Marin Coastal Watersheds Permit Coordination Program
Proposed 2026 Riparian Restoration and Pollinator Garden Projects
Public Comment Period: September 9, 2026 – October 10, 2026

Marin Resource Conservation District (MRCD) invites public comment on 4 projects adopted into the Marin Permit Coordination Program (PCP), an Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration. The PCP provides streamlined CEQA compliance for use of 53 conservation practices up to a certain scope in certain watersheds within Marin County by MRCD and their partners.

One of the four projects will provide landscape enhancement, pollinator habitat and educational opportunities connected to native plants and enhance water quality at Walker Creek Outdoor School Campus. The other three are riparian restorations aimed at erosion control and native habitat by planting native riparian species. NRCS practices are Fence (382) Riparian Forest Buffer (391) Brush Management (314) Prescribed Grazing (528) Tree & Shrub Establishment (612).
