ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

A Bid is invited for the construction of a *Heavy use area repair and hardening, post-hole drilling and ramp construction –Project 2022-01* and *Livestock water facility – Project 2022-02,* near Woodacre in Marin County, CA. This work requires a California State Contractor's License, applicable to the scope of work. Class, A, B or C27 expected.

Sealed bids are due no later than 12:00 p.m. PST on October 5th, 2022, at the MRCD office at 80 Fourth Street – Ste 202, Point Reyes Station, CA 94956 for work described, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read. The bids can be mailed to the MRCD at PO Box 1146, Point Reyes Station, CA 94956 or hand delivered to the physical address above but only bids that arrive by the deadline stated above will be considered. Thereafter, bids will be evaluated, and a contract may be awarded on October 13th, 2022. The MRCD reserves the right to reject any or all bids and/or accept the bid most advantageous to the District.

If you are interested in bidding on the project, please contact the MRCD, for a set of Bid Documents, which includes instructions to bidders, a cost proposal form, plans and specifications, and sample contract documents. The Bid Documents will be available on September 21st, 2022.

Bids shall be accompanied by a 5% bid bond or certified check as a guarantee that if a bid is accepted, a contract will be entered into. A performance bond furnished for the full amount of the contract will be required before a contract can be approved.
